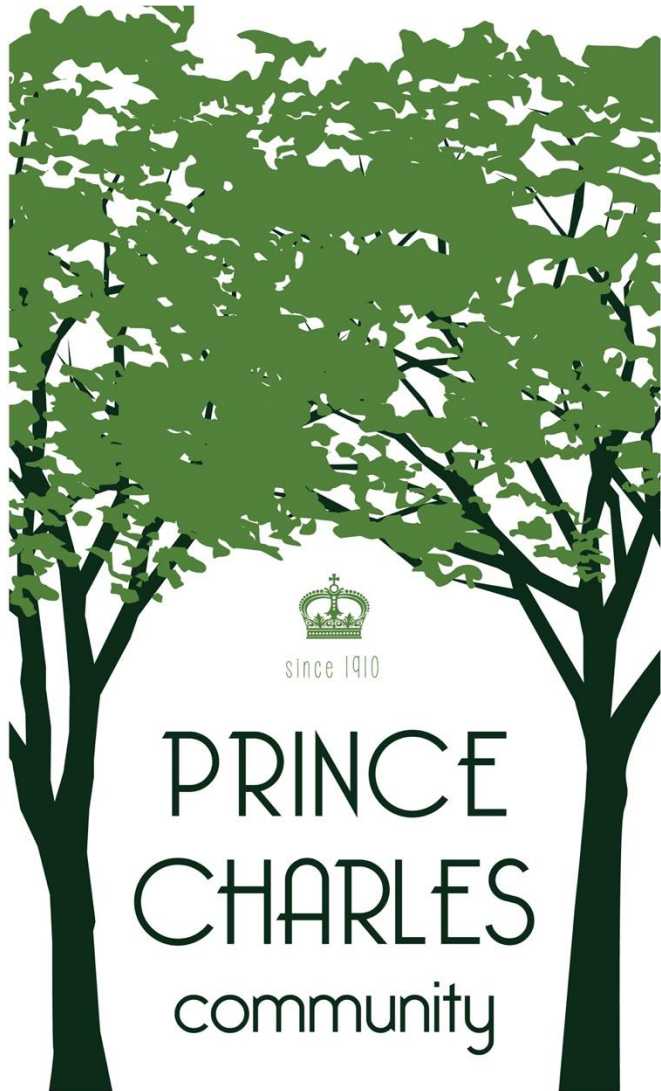

WINTER IS AROUND THE CORNER!

Since it's getting chillier out, now is the time to make sure everything is in working order!

- **Test your thermostat!** Turn it up and make sure it is blowing warm air.
- **Replace your furnace filter.** This needs to be done at least every 3 months. When your filter is clogged, your furnace may overheat and stop blowing hot air.
- **Check your doors and windows for gaps.** A little bit of weatherstripping can go a long way! Look for any gaps where warm air might escape and use caulking or weatherstripping to fill those gaps.

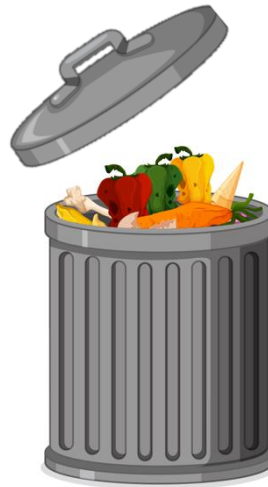
2-1-1 is accessible 24/7.

GARBAGE DAY IS TUESDAY!

Garbage and recycling are collected weekly on the **same** day of the week, year-round, including statutory holidays! The only exceptions are **Christmas Day** (December 25) and **New Year's Day** (January 1). **Garbage** and blue bags must be out by 7 A.M. Do not set your containers or waste out before 4 P.M the day before pickup!

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH: BASICS AND INFORMATION

Goal of Neighbourhood Watch to Have Residents Reporting Suspicious Activity to Police

You've probably seen a *Neighborhood Watch* street sign at least once. These signs notify visitors that suspicious people and activities are related to police.

Our main objective is to have as many residents as possible actively participating in their neighbourhood so that any threats to the area will be reported to police, thus avoiding the occurrence of a crime. We encourage residents to watch out for each other to reduce crime in the city.

Edmonton Neighbourhood Watch members are the eyes and ears of the community. Our members report any suspicious activity in their neighbourhoods, whenever they occur.

We are always vigilant!

Who is it? The Edmonton Neighbourhood Watch Program is a program filled with volunteers. The strength of the program is based on the efforts of our members in each neighbourhood. 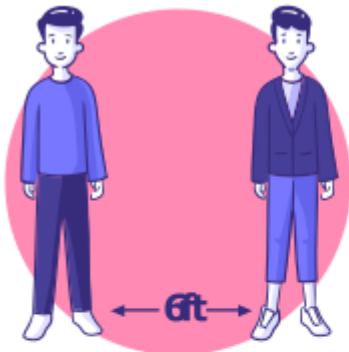
