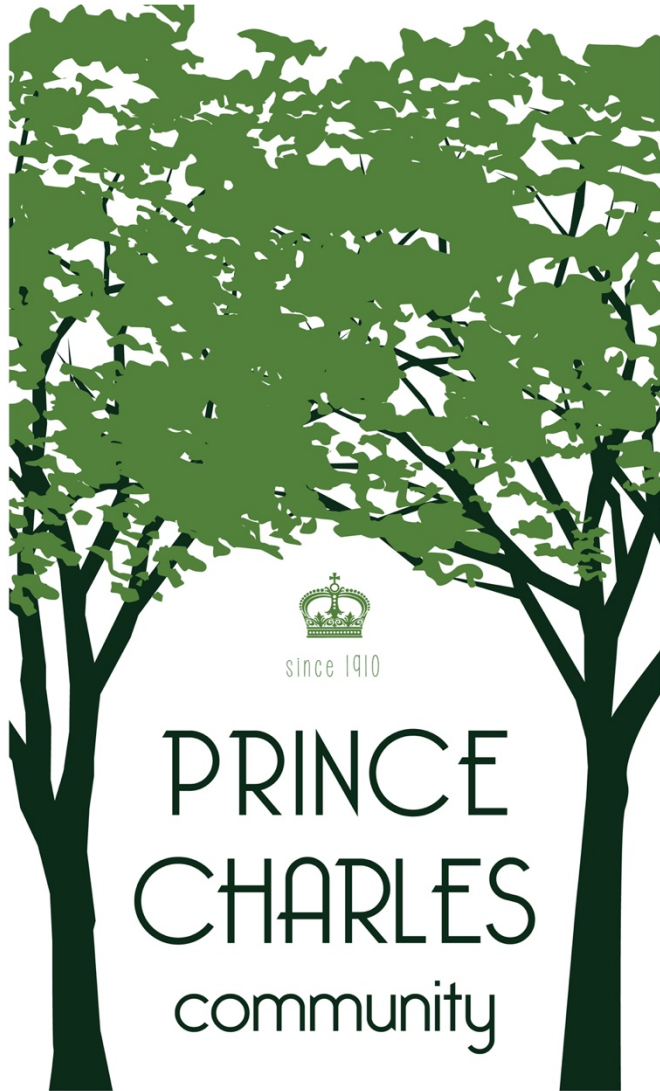

# February Crime Prevention Tips

*Here are a few tips to help keep you safe.*

It's okay to develop friendships and relationships online. It shouldn't come as a complete surprise to you, but people online aren't always who they say they are, so trust your instincts. If something doesn't seem right, then it probably isn't.

- ♥ Don't disclose private information on online dating sites.
- ♥ Keep initial contact on the dating site platform; don't move to other social media sites until you are happy that the person you are talking to appears genuine.
- ♥ Ask as many questions as possible about the person and don't rush into a relationship. Don't feel pressured to meet before you are ready.
- ♥ Never send money to anyone that you are talking to, no matter what their story.
- ♥ Don't share any personal images, once you press 'send' you can never get these images back.
- ♥ Talk to friends and family about your online relationships, and always tell someone where and when, if you decide to meet.
- ♥ Always meet and stay in a public place.
- ♥ Don't be afraid to get up and leave if things aren't going well.
- ♥ If you are consuming alcohol, limit the amount, and only take a drink that you've seen being poured. Never leave a drink unattended.

### DO YOU KNOW THESE FAMOUS BLACK CANADIANS?

- \* **Jully Black:** Jully Black was born in 1977 and is known as one of the “25 Greatest Canadian Singers Ever.” This Canadian Queen of R&B and Grammy Award winner has collaborated with well-known artists like Kardinal Offishall and has written songs for Destiny’s Child and Missy Elliot (among others).
- \* **George Elliot Clarke:** George Elliot Clarke is an Africadian poet and playwright and is the current Canadian Parliamentary Poet Laureate. Clarke is a 7<sup>th</sup> generation Canadian of African-Canadian and Mi’kmaq Amerindian heritage and his work explores and chronicles the history of Black Canadian communities of Nova Scotia and New Brunswick.

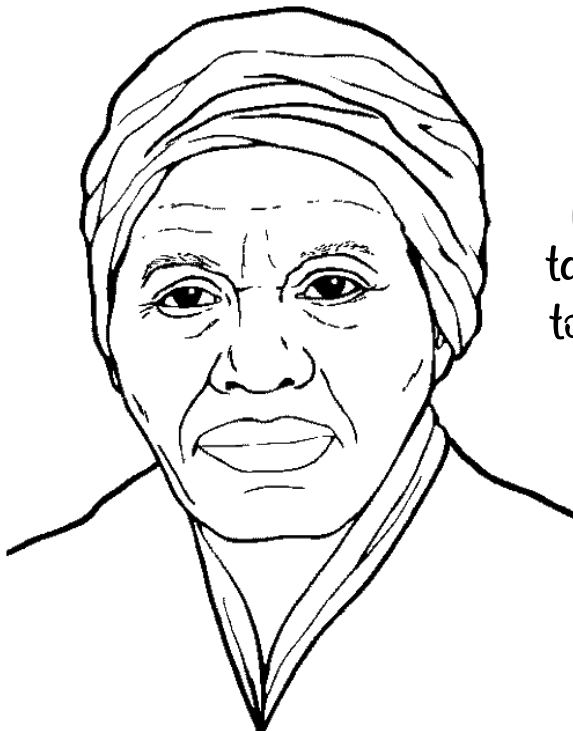

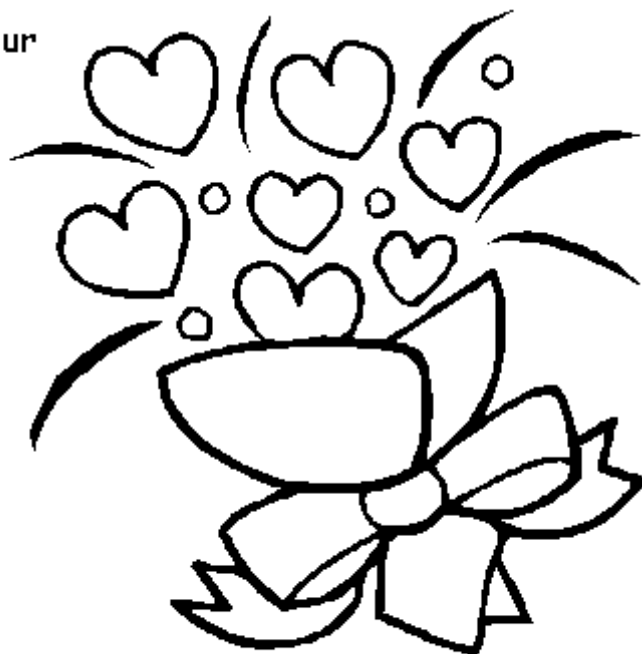

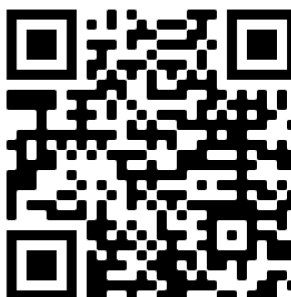
