In 2019, the Edmonton Police Service received reports of online scams with an overall loss of \$5,690,629.10. Compared to 2018, with 360 incidents reported with an overall loss of \$1,214,599.82.

The impact of fraud so far this year

As of February 29, 2020

- Canadian reports of fraud:
7,804
(46,317 in 2019)
- Canadian victims of fraud:
4,119
(19,285 in 2019)
- Lost to fraud:
\$9.2M
(\$98M in 2019)

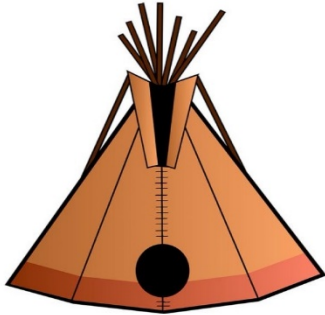

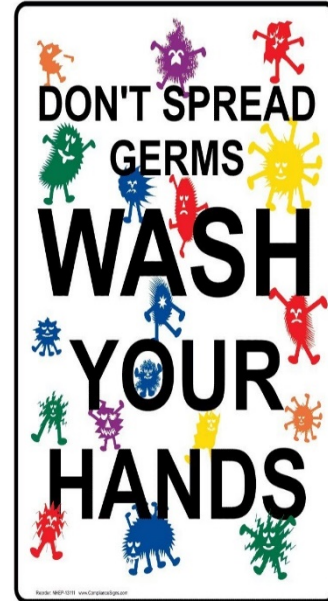
